

GTH Chromebook PARENT/GUARDIAN RESPONSIBILITIES

Before a device can be issued to students for school use, parents must sign the Policy Agreement

AN UPDATE TO CHROMEBOOK POLICY: STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO TAKE HOME A SCHOOL OWNED DEVICE FOR ANY REASON!

- Students will still be able to use a school owned Chromebook during school hours for any classroom needs.
- Students will be held responsible for any damage, theft, or loss that occurs while using a school owned Chromebook.
- Therefore, the parent/guardian is responsible for the cost of repair or replacement of a Chromebook that is damaged, lost, or stolen but not reported.

GTH Chromebook Policy, Procedures & Information Handbook

This handbook serves as a resource for both students and parents. Parents and students must read this handbook and then agree to comply with the requirements contained within the handbook.

The completed form will be collected at the time of Chromebook distribution. Students will not be allowed to use a Chromebook until this form is signed and returned by a parent/guardian.

I acknowledge both my student and I agree to all terms outlined in the Green Tech High Charter Student Handbook. I understand my child is responsible for his actions with technology resources owned by the Green Tech High Charter School.

- My student understands to be careful with his device, and to tell an adult if something happens to the device, or the
 device is lost. If a device is lost, an affidavit form must be filled out. There will be a 40.00 repair fee for any damage
 outside of normal wear and tear that may not be covered by the insurance fee. Loss of or replacement of the charger
 will incur a 25.00 fee. If the device is stolen, a police report must be filed by the parent and turned into the school
 office.
- If a student is having a software/hardware issue, please contact techsupport@greentechhigh.org.

My student has no expectation of privacy with any usage of the device. The school may, without prior notice or consent, log, supervise, access, view, monitor, and record use at any time and for any reason.

I understand my student will have their Internet access monitored. A "filter" will be applied to their Internet browsing to block inappropriate content. However, no filtering technology is perfect and inappropriate content may still be viewable. The final responsibility to avoid inappropriate websites rests with my child.

Any violations of this agreement and/or procedure may result in fine charges owed to the School.

By signing the Chromebook Policy & Procedure Agreement, you commit to the student expectations and understand the consequences for violations.
